How to find us:

Kala Sangam is just a 5 min walk from both Bradford Interchange and Bradford Forster Square stations. Find us between Bradford Cathedral and The Broadway shopping centre.

Safe and secure parking is available just over the road in The Broadway (BD1 1JR) for just £5 all day weekdays, £1.50 all day weekends and £1 from 5pm to midnight.

The building is fully accessible with a lift to all floors.





When the late Bradford based poet Mohammad Hafeez Johar passed away one of his prized possessions – a Pentax camera – was gifted to his daughter Nabeelah Hafeez, a promising poet in her own right.

Through my Father's Lens brings together poetry from both father and daughter in both English and Urdu. These words will be accompanied by photographs from the 70s, 80s and 90s taken by Hafeez Johar, and images of Bradford captured by Nabeelah using that same treasured camera.

In words and images, Through my Father's Lens aims to provide an insight into the lives of the Pakistani community in the city, showing migration as a journey of identity through the experience of second and third generation migrants.

Dastaan meaning a 'story' or story of our life', is a riveting experience of live music and visuals. World renowned tabla maestro and composer Sarvar Sabri leads an ensemble of five exquisite musicians of different musical genres playing instruments including tabla, setar (Iran) harp, vocals and a few surprises!

In the first half, the musicians delve into a journey of personal stories gathered from poets and travellers, inspired by folk music of India, Persia and Wales with added hints of jazz. The second half reveals an emotionally charged film of love, separation, and wonder, explored through the beauty of Persian calligraphy Nasta'liq and poignant dance, seamlessly complemented with live music.

The film features internationally renowned Birmingham Royal Ballet Associate Director Marion Tait CBE and Master calligrapher from Iran, Mehdi Jamali. The film is simply poetry in motion and had its premiere at The British Library, London.

'Dastaan' is a meeting of interlinked cultures of familiar and unfamiliar lands, celebrating the unique diversity of Britain.
